

























































































When you build the support beams, remember to push each piece down as far as it can go—all the way to the bottom of the rod. Well done!




























BUILDING TIP

3. Draw a curving line to finish the tail. Add lines for stripes and a dot for an eye.



1. Draw a small, flat sideways teardrop. Add a long curved line as shown.

2. Draw another long curved line that ends close to the first curve.



3. Connect the curved lines with a wavy line. Add eyes, fins, and a smile.




